



**Chris Mills** is a 54-year resident of Palm Springs and a respected architect in the Coachella Valley who may be best known for his innovative design of the “Nude Bridge,” a covered bridge structure which crosses over Indian Canyon Drive to a local nudist resort. Mills holds a degree in architecture from Arizona State University.

Mills was first elected to serve a four-year term on the Palm Springs City Council in November 2001 and has served the City of Palm Springs for a total of 15 years.

Mills currently serves on a host of City Council Subcommittees, including Downtown Museum Market Plaza Project, Vacation Rentals, Library Remodel/Expansion, Measure J, BUZZ Trolley, Historic Site Preservation Code, Vacation Building and Lot Regulations, Holiday Lighting, Sign Ordinance, City Hall Landscaping, Tahquitz Median Landscaping and Plaza Racquet Club.

Mills lives in Palm Springs with his wife Dawn, with whom he has two grown daughters. He is a skilled softball player and also enjoys golfing at the city’s two public courses at Tahquitz Creek Golf Resort.
